

Hardship Fund Guidance Notes

Who is the Lee Abbey Hardship Fund for?

The Lee Abbey Hardship Fund is primarily available to help any full-time student who has been a resident at Lee Abbey for at least 1 academic year and is still booked in for at least 1 more full term, who is experiencing financial difficulty. Priority in the allocation of assistance is given to international students and students with a disability or special medical needs.

The Hardship Fund may also be used to assist a voluntary member of the Lee Abbey Christian Community who is experiencing unexpected financial difficulty due to unforeseen circumstances.

All residents at Lee Abbey are expected to make adequate provisions to finance their studies and accommodation; however we understand that some students may need some additional support. It may be that you have experienced a change in circumstances which has reduced the funds available to you, or you may have one-off unexpected costs. In such cases we may be able to assist you with a grant. Grants are usually not less than £100 and not more than £500.

Please note that grants are not available to assist with payment of Lee Abbey accommodation fees.

Completing your application

Please read each question carefully and make sure you answer it fully. If you do not answer the questions we may contact you for more information and our decision may be delayed.

If you are asking for assistance with specific costs, you will need to show confirmation of these costs.

You must supply three months' recent bank statements for all your bank accounts. Please ensure that the documents you provide are **photocopies** of the originals.

If your college/university has a hardship fund, you must show that you have applied for assistance from your school first before applying for assistance from Lee Abbey.

It may be helpful to ask your tutor or student advisor to provide a statement in support of your application.

Please submit your application to Reception, marked for the attention of the Director.

Reviewing your application

Once we receive your application, your situation will be discussed by the Director and at least 2 other members of the Lee Abbey Leadership Team.

If we have questions about your situation, you may be asked to attend an interview to explain your circumstances in more detail.

We aim to advise you of the outcome of your application within 10 days of receiving your completed form.
